

Privacy Policy

Howth Sea Angling Club are committed to protecting and respecting your privacy. For any personal data you provide for the purposes of your membership, Derek Gillespie (Club Secretary) is the Data Controller and is responsible for storing and otherwise processing that data in a fair, lawful, secure, and transparent way.

What personal data we hold on you

You may give us information about you by filling in forms at an event or online, or by corresponding with us by phone, e-mail or otherwise. This includes information you provide when you register with Howth Sea Angling Club. The information you give us may include your name, date of birth, address, e-mail address, phone number, name of other angling clubs with which you are registered and gender to be known as Angling Data

Why we need your personal data

The reason we need your Angling Data is to administer your membership and to provide the membership services you are signing up to when you register with the club. Our lawful basis for processing your personal is that we have a contractual obligation to you as a member to provide the services you are registering for.

Reasons we need to process your data include:

For training and competition entry

- sharing personal data with club coaches or officials to administer training sessions;
- sharing personal data with club team managers to enter events;
- sharing personal data with facility providers to manage access to the track or check delivery standards; and
- sharing personal data with other clubs, Provincial Councils and other competition providers for entry in events.
- publishing of competition results and images

For funding and reporting purposes

- sharing anonymised data with a funding partner as condition of grant funding e.g. Local Authority;
- analysing anonymised data to monitor club trends; and
- sending an annual club survey to improve your experience as a club member

For membership and club management

- processing of membership forms and payments;
- sharing data with committee members to provide information about club activities, membership renewals or invitation to social events;
- club newsletter promoting club activity
- sharing data with the IFSA for membership, data analysis and insurance purposes

Marketing and communications (where separate consent is provided)

- sending information about promotions and offers from sponsors;
- sending information about selling club kit, merchandise or fundraising.

The club has the following social media pages which images of you may be used, Google suite of software, Facebook, WhatsApp, Official Website, and Instagram. All members are free to join these pages. If you join one of the Social Media pages, please note that provider of the social media platform(s) has their own privacy policies and that the club do not accept any responsibility or liability for these policies.

Who we share your personal data with

When you become a member of Howth Sea Angling Club, you will also automatically be eligible to registered as a member of the Irish Federation of Sea Anglers IFSA. If you wish to join the IFSA following fees paid, we will provide the IFSA with your Angling Data. The Club does not supply any personal data it holds for this purpose to any other third party outside our Club partners (insurance companies etc)

How long we hold your personal data

We will hold your personal data on file for as long as you are a member with us and 3 years post membership ceasing. Angling data is updated every year. Any personal data we hold on you will be securely destroyed after three years of non-membership. Your data is not processed for any further purposes other than those detailed in this policy. In cases your personal Data may be deleted immediately once membership has ceased

Your rights regarding your personal data

As a data subject you may have the right at any time to request access to, rectification or erasure of your personal data; to restrict or object to certain kinds of processing of your personal data, including direct marketing. Members can request a copy of all information held about them which will be provided within 30 days.

As a data subject you are not obliged to share your personal data with the Club. If you choose not to share your personal data with Howth Sea Angling Club, we may not be able to register or administer your membership.
